Overview

- Module for the wireless integration of spatially separated DALI ballasts in a DALI system.
- At least one transmitter (sending unit) and one receiver (receiving unit) are required for the wireless connection.
- Range of the wireless connection is up to 300m outdoors, 10m-20m inside buildings.
- Easy configuration with the <u>DALI</u> <u>Cockpit</u> Software and suitable interface.
- Broadcast commands and commands sent to groups assigned to the receiver are forwarded to the receiver subnet.
- Commands are sent broadcast on the subnet.
- Support of DALI-2 control commands.

- The transmitter is supplied by the DALI power supply of the main DALI line.
- Receiver variant Art.Nr. 89453321-GRR is supplied by the DALI power supply of the DALI subnet.
- Receiver variant Art.Nr.: 89453321-GRRPS: is supplied by mains and provides a 20mA DALI bus power supply for the subnet. If more power is required, the DALI sub-circuit can be extended with a DALI-Expander.
- Unlimited DALI sub-circuits can be controlled with one transmitter (a receiver is required for each subnet).
- 2 sets of DALI terminals for easy connection – the DALI line can be connected through the device.






connection plan wDALI-2 BT5 Long Range Transmitter 89453321-GRTM






dimensions wDALI-2 BT5 Long Range Receiver 89453321-GRR

connection plan wDALI-2 BT5 Long Range Receiver 89453321-GRR







Installation

The devices are intended for back box installation or in an enclosure, ensure proper cable relief for installation in protection class II devices

wDALI-2 BT5 Long Range Transmitter (Art.Nr. 89453321-GRTM) and wDALI-2 BT5 Long Range Receiver (Art.Nr. 89453321-GRR)

- The wDALI-2 BT5 Long Range Transmitter (Art.Nr.: 89453321-GRTM) as well as the wDALI-2 BT5 Long Range Receiver (Art.Nr.: 89453321-GRR) are connected directly to the DALI bus and supplied by it (current consumption typical 3.8 mA). A DALI bus power supply is required.
- The connection to the DALI terminals can be made regardless of polarity, it is protected against overvoltage (mains voltage).

wDALI-2 BT5 Long Range Receiver PS20 (Art.Nr. 89453321-GRR)

- o Connect power supply terminals L and N to mains voltage according to the labelling.
- o The wDALI-2 BT5 Long Range Receiver PS20 (item no. 89453321-GRR) is supplied from the mains and provides a 20mA DALI bus supply for the subnet. If the power supply is insufficient, the subcircuit can be extended with a DALI-Expander.
- There are two sets of DALI terminals for easy connection, the signal line can be looped through.
- The wiring should be carried out as a permanent installation in a dry and clean environment.

- Installation may only be carried out in a voltage-free state of the system and by qualified specialists.
- National regulations for setting up electrical systems must be followed.
- The DALI line may be routed together with the mains voltage (in one cable or as single wires in a tube)
- The DALI-line must not be connected to mains or an extra low voltage system (SELV)
- Only 1 wire may be connected to each terminal. When using double wire end ferrules, the connection capacity of the terminal must be considered.
- The DALI wiring can be realised with standard low-voltage installation material. No special cables are required.
- Wiring topology of the DALI-line: Line, Tree, Star



Attention: The DALI-signal is not classified as SELV circuit (Safety Extra Low Voltage). Therefore, the installation regulations for low voltage apply.



The voltage drop on the DALI line must not exceed 2V at maximum length (300m) and maximum bus load (250mA).

Do not use standard DC power supplies on the DALI-line, since they do not meet the requirements for DALI communication



Commissioning

The modules are ready for operation after connection.

Coupling of the Transmitter and Receiver is not necessary. Receivers and Transmitters have the same pairing number as default and are thus automatically linked.

The receiving range depends on the structural conditions, outside it is up to 300m, in buildings the range is typically 10m-20m.

Commands sent broadcast on the main DALI line are forwarded to the subnet, in addition one of the 16 DALI groups (G0...G15) can be assigned to a Receiver via the DALI Cockpit, see section "Function & Configuration".

Function & Configuration

The wDALI-2 BT5.0 Long Range Transmitter and Receiver allows the integration of spatially separated DALI ballasts in a DALI-line without them being physically connected.

The DALI commands are transmitted wirelessly to all receivers. The receivers filter the commands accordingly: only Broadcast commands and commands sent to the respective group are forwarded to the DALI subnet. The received commands are always sent broadcast on the DALI subnet.

For group configuration the software tool <u>DALI</u> <u>Cockpit</u> is required. The PC must be connected to the DALI bus via a suitable Lunatone interface module (<u>DALI USB</u>, <u>DALI 4Net</u>, <u>DALI SCI RS232</u>, <u>DALI-2 IOT</u>, <u>DALI-2 WLAN</u>,..).




Figure 1 DALI Cockpit device configuration w-DALI-2 BT5 Long Range Receiver

The wDALI-2 BT5 Long Range Receiver is automatically recognized by the DALI Cockpit during the addressing process and displayed in the device overview. DALI Cockpit device page see Figure 1 below.

Additionally the pairing number of transmitters and receivers can be changed in the DALI Cockpit, if receivers and transmitters in the same reception area should not be interconnected. The same pairing number needs to be entered in the Transmitter and Receiver
